


A2004 Quick Guide




The front panel



1	Power key In any mode: Press to show the Display setup dialog. Repeat short presses to toggle preset light levels. In Standby mode: Press and hold to turn the autopilot system to Sleep mode. Re-press the key to re-activate the system.
2	MENU key Press once to display the Quick menu. Press twice to show the Settings menu.
3	X key Press to return to previous menu level or to exit a dialog. Press and hold to exit the menu system and return to last active mode page.
4	 Rotary knob Menu and dialog operation: Turn to move up and down in menus and dialogs Turn to adjust a value Press to select a menu option and to enter the next menu level In Standby and NFU mode: Press to activate Follow up (FU) mode. In FU mode: Turn to set the rudder angle. In automatic modes: Turn to change the set heading/set course, press to re-activate automatic mode with current heading/course as reference.
5	STBY key Press to activate Standby mode.

6	AUTO key Press to activate last active mode (AUTO or NoDrift), and to display the mode pop- up menu.
	Repeat pressing the key to toggle the pop-up menu options.
7	NAV key Press to activate Nav (Navigation) mode.
8	WORK /Thruster key Press to display work profile options. Repeat short presses to toggle the work profile options. Press and hold to activate or de-activate the thruster.

9	< and > (port and starboard) keys
and	In Standby and FU mode: Press to activate Non-Follow Up (NFU) steering.
11	In automatic modes: Press to change the set heading/set course to port or to starboard.
10	Turn key Press to display the Turn-dialog.

Acknowledging an alert



The most recent alert is acknowledged by pressing the rotary knob. This removes the alert notification, and silences the alert from all units that belong to the same alert group. A reminder reappears at given intervals for as long as the alert condition exists.

There is no time-out on the alert message or siren. An alert remains active until you acknowledge it or until the reason for the alert is removed.





Thrusters on/off
